



# 2017-18 TSLSC Junior Craft Policy

## Purpose

To ensure that all members of the club have access to suitable craft relative to their skill level and needs and minimize unnecessary damage to craft.

## Details

Craft will be placed into three categories which determine who can use the craft. In addition to this the size of the craft will be marked (small, medium, large) to ensure people are using craft which is suited to their height or weight.

## Categories

<b>A</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Allocated Craft</li><li>• Allocated as per allocation policy</li><li>• Craft bond required</li></ul>
<b>T</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Training squad use only</li><li>• For use by people when training in club squads only</li></ul>
<b>G</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• General use</li><li>• For use of by all paid club members</li></ul>

## Gear Repair

When equipment is damaged the individual must alert the Gear Steward to the damage ASAP. If the craft cannot be repaired by the Gear Steward or another Club Member, the Gear Steward will contact an approved repairer and organise the damaged equipment to be repaired. The Gear Steward will notify the individual of the allocated board of the cost of repairs and where the board needs to be transport to and from for repairs. **Any equipment marked with a Yellow tag is under repair and cannot be used.**

## Conditions of Use

- Treat all gear with respect
- Wash all gear down and return to storage immediately after use
- Carry not drag gear; if you need help ask
- Don't leave gear in the sun
- Notify the gear steward immediately when gear is damaged
- No stand up surfing on paddle boards
- Don't take equipment away from the club without permission from the gear steward
- When travelling to carnivals boards may be taken at the last training session before Carnival
- Return Equipment at first training session after Carnival
- Club craft can only be used by Water Safety qualified members, or by junior members under the supervision of Water Safety qualified members, in accordance with SLS Water Safety Policy and Procedures

## Allocation

The club has committed to a structured sports program which is designed for individuals to excel and as part of this program racing equipment will be made available to be allocated to individuals for their sole use in training and competition.

In order to qualify for allocation individuals must be:

- Paid financial members of TSLSC
- Fill out an application form and return to the Head Coach
- Abide by the conditions above and on the application form

Equipment will be allocated by the Gear Steward and Head Coach, please contact the Head Coach for more information.

## **Junior Equipment Allocation Application Form**

Individuals that wish to have equipment allocation need to read and complete this form and hand or email to Troy Beaumont at [troybeaumont@exemail.com.au](mailto:troybeaumont@exemail.com.au) before you start training.

### **Expectations of Athlete:**

- In consultation with the Head Coach commit to a structured training and competition plan for the 2014-15 season
- Store the gear in a safe and secure location when it is away from the club
- Transport the gear in the correct way
- Abide by the conditions of use for club equipment
- Return the equipment to the club if requested by the Gear Steward or Head Coach
- Set an example for other members at club trainings (turn up on time, train properly, etc.)
- Ensure that the equipment allocated is used by themselves only not friends or family

### **Eligibility:**

Those that wish to get individual gear allocated to them must fulfil the following requirements:

- Be committed to training
- Demonstrate a good training ethic to the Head Coach
- Have a desire to further their skills and achieve the best possible result they can at the relevant Carnivals for their age group
- Be a current financial member of TSLSC

### **Selection Criteria:**

When choosing which piece of equipment to allocate the Club Coach and Gear Steward will take the following into account:

- Height and weight of athlete
- Previous seasons results and training habits
- Potential to achieve results
- Amount of equipment available to be allocated
- Experience of the athlete

### **Damage:**

In the event that the equipment becomes damaged the athlete will:

- Inform the gear steward ASAP
- If needed transport equipment to an approved repairer once the Gear Steward notifies them
- Pay repair costs, if any
- Not use the equipment until it is repaired

### **Ownership:**

At all times the allocated equipment remains the property of TSLSC exclusively.
