This is just a reminder to all club members in regards to the purpose and usage of the ATV within Thirroul Surf Club.

The All-Terrain Vehicle (ATV) has been supplied by Thirroul Surf Club for Lifesaving purposes only. **This is only to be used for towing Jet Skis, IRB's and Patrol Gear Equipment and conducting Roving Patrols ONLY.**

**PLEASE NOTE: The ATV is to be driven in a safe and controlled manner. The speed limit for the ATV in populated areas is 5-10 kms and in open areas 25 kms unless responding to an incident. However care must be taken when responding.**

**Also please be reminded that:**

All ATV drivers must be 17years of age, hold a current and proficient:

- Driver's License (Provisional or Open)
- Financial member or employed lifeguard (in active duty)

All ATV drivers must:

- Complete the ATV Vehicle Induction Checklist under supervision of a nominated club officer
- Be registered as an ATV Driver on Surfguard

If clubs break these rules and requirements, penalties and further actions will be taken.
